PARTICIPATIVE BUDGETS

The Mijas Town Hall is developing a pilot experience with Participatory Budgeting. To develop it, **1.5 million Euros** have been reserved from the municipal budget for 2019 to be spent on what the citizens decide through a **direct and binding vote**.

HOW CAN I PARTICIPATE?

1- Proposal

From **May 15th to June 15th**, citizens can send their proposals through the municipal website (www.mijas.es) or through the registry of the Town Hall. In addition, workshops will be held to collect proposals in associations, schools, senior centers, etc. If you want to organize one in your centre or association write to us to participa@mijas.es

Proposals must be **endorsed by at least 15 people** aged 16 or over and registered in Mijas. Those who wish to participate must collect the maximum number of endorsements possible (each person can endorse as many proposals as they deem appropriate), as the proposals with more endorsements are those that will go on to the next phase.

2 - Explaining your proposal

The proposals of the residents will be discussed in the **Area Assembly**, where they will decide which are the priority ones, so it will be necessary for them to go to the assembly to explain and defend their proposal.

3 - Voting

The final voting period will take place the **20th of September and the 20th of October**. You can vote through the municipal. On Thursday, **October 18th** a ballot box will be set up in each of the three zones and there will be a mobile ballot box that will be taken through different schools, senior centers, etc. between October 1st and November 9th. If you want the mobile ballot box to go to your centre, write to us!



You have to be over 16 to vote at the moment of voting and be registered on the Mijas Town Hall Citizens Registry the "Padron".

4 - 2019 How is it done?

In 2019, the most voted proposals will be made carried out, until the budget allocated to each zone is exhausted, which has been distributed proportionally among our three population centres: Mijas Village, La Cala and Las Lagunas (500,000 euros for each zone).
