



MUNICIPAL BYLAW

Ms Ana Carmen Mata Rico, Mayoress-President of Mijas Town Hall, in use of the powers conferred upon her by Article 21.1.f) of the current Law 7/1985, of 2nd April, which regulates the Bases of the Local Government,

INFORMS

In view of the high temperatures that are expected in our town during the current summer season, and with the aim of protecting the health and wellbeing of the owners and drivers of donkey-taxis and donkey-carriages, the horse drivers operating in our municipality, as well as preserving the health and wellbeing of the animals themselves when providing donkey-taxi, donkey-carriage and horse-drawn carriage services (authorised by the granting of the corresponding municipal licence as a tourist service), the following information is hereby provided:

FIRST: The service must be provided in strict accordance to article 15 of the current "Municipal Bylaw regulating the service of Donkey-Taxis, Donkey-carriages and Horse Carriages in the municipality of Mijas", approved by Mijas Town Hall on 30th November, 2011 (published in the Official Bulletin of Malaga province -BOP- No. 25 of 7th February, 2012). By virtue of the aforementioned precept, in case of public interest and by means of a reasoned agreement, the route and timetables of the service may be modified.

Equines providing the above services shall not be subjected to such services between 14.00 and 18.00 hours when a yellow warning has been issued by the State Meteorological Agency (AEMET).

With the same purpose as stated above, the service regulated in the aforementioned by-law shall not be provided on days when an orange or red warning is issued by the State Meteorological Agency (AEMET).

On the other hand, the below table shows the feels-like temperature values, as well as recommendations, included in the "Guide of good practices for the welfare of horses in public service carriages" published by the General Council of the Spanish College of Veterinarians (copies of the same will be provided to the owners of the service offered in this municipality of Mijas).

- Precaución 27 a 32 Posible fatiga por exposición prolongada o actividad física.
- Precaución extrema 33 a 40 Insolación, golpe de calor, calambres. Posibles por exposición prolongada o actividad física.
- Peligro 41 a 53 Insolación, golpe de calor, calambres. Muy posibles por exposición prolongada o actividad física.
- Peligro extremo 54 ó más Golpe de calor, insolación inminente.

Permanecer bajo el sol puede incrementar los valores del índice de calor en 8 C.
 Cuando la temperatura es menor que 32 C (temperatura de la piel), el viento disminuye la sensación térmica. Si es mayor de 32 C, la aumenta.

RELATIVE HUMIDITY (%)
AIR TEMPRATURE IN CELSIUS (C)

Precaution: 27 to 32: Possible fatigue due to prolonged exposure or physical activity.
Extreme precaution: 33 to 40: Possible sunstroke, heat stroke, cramps due to prolonged sun exposure or physical activity.
Danger: 41 to 53: Very likely sunstroke, heat stroke, cramps due to prolonged exposure or physical activity.
Extreme danger: 54 or more: Imminent heat stroke or sunstroke.

Staying under the sun may increase the heat index values to 8 C.
When the temperature is less than 32 C (skin temperature), the wind reduces the feels-like temperature. If it is higher tan 32 C, it increases it.

SECOND: This By-law shall be effective from the date of its publication on the municipal website and shall remain in force until further notice.
